**DISCIPLINE: Chap 19 Sec 7 & Chap 17 Sec 7** It shall be the duty and obligation of the trial-giving club to see that a judge, club official, ring steward, volunteer, or competitor at an any Obedience or Rally Obedience Trial held under these regulations, is not subject to indignities of any kind, The trial Committee Chair shall promptly report to the CKC any infringement of this regulation, and the Discipline Committee shall have the authority to take such action as it deems fit on receipt of a report indicating that this has occurred. A copy of this regulation shall be prominently placed in every premium list and catalogue.

#### **MOVING UP – RALLY**

CKC RULES AND REGULATIONS (EFFECTIVE JANUARY 01, 2007)

6.7.1 A dog that is registered in the records of the CKC or has a PEN, an ERN, or a MCN and has fulfilled the requirements for a title in accordance with these rules, may be moved to the next level of competition. The transfer must be submitted to the trial secretary on the appropriate move-up form by the owner or handler one hour before the opening of the first trial on that day, schedule permitting.

6.7.2 If it is established by the CKC that a dog moved up to the next level has not completed the requirements for the lower level before moving up, then all qualifying ribbons and/or awards earned by the dog incorrectly entered shall be forfeited and cancelled by the CKC and the owner may be subject to disciplinary action.

6.7.3 In order for a dog to be eligible to move up, the dog must be registered in the records of the CKC or have a Performance Event Number (PEN), or an Event Registration Number (ERN) or a Miscellaneous Certification Number (MCN) before entries close. The addition of a CKC number after close of entries does not make the dog eligible and will result in referral to the Discipline Committee.

Class descriptions are as set out in The CKC Rules and Regulation book:

**Section 9** – Novice, **Section 10** – Advanced, **Section 11**- Excellent,

**Section 12** – Rally Advanced Excellent Title, **Section 13** – Exhibition only

#### **General Entry Information**

- All entry confirmations and **Judging Schedules** will be mailed if requested, otherwise sent via email, as soon as possible after entries close.
- Exhibitors must abide by errors made in entering their dogs regardless of how or by whom the entries were made.
- Only dogs eligible for registration with CKC may enter this show and trial.
- The **Show precincts** will be the entire Building housing the show.
- The **Muskoka District Kennel Club** will not be responsible for any items left overnight.
- The Show Superintendent will be in full charge of the show, governed by CKC rules. If, because of riot, civil disturbance or other acts beyond the controls of the management, it is impossible to open or complete the show or trial, no refund of Entry Fees will be made.
- The **Muskoka District Kennel Club** will use care and diligence for the welfare of all dogs, exhibitors and spectators but will not be responsible for, nor assume any liability in the event of accident or misfortunes, however caused.
- **BITCHES IN SEASON:** Refunds for bitches in season will be given provided the exhibitor supplies a veterinary certificate stating that the bitch was in season the 10 day period preceding the trial. The certificate must be presented prior to the day of the trials or before judging commences on the day of the trials.
- An **ERN** number must be obtained within 30 days of obtaining points, awards or scores to avoid cancellation. If factors beyond your control prohibits this or presents a problem, please send a written request for a 30 day extension to The Canadian Kennel Club.
